Littlehampton Community Fridge

The community fridge has moved out of St James' Church in Littlehampton and now runs from various venues in and around Littlehampton.

Mixture of fresh and frozen food, bakery items, and long-life products.

Anyone can come and take 5 items per adult per day (plus bread). It costs nothing, as all the food is rescued and needs a home to stop it being wasted. Bring a bag.

St Peters and St Pauls Pantry - Rustington Church Hall, 77, The Street, Rustington BN16 3NL

A space where people in the community who are struggling to get by can top up their



weekly food supplies - no referral or registration needed. Food is a mixture of fresh, frozen and long life, a mixture of donations and surplus from businesses. **Opening times:** 1st Wed of the month 4-6pm, 2nd Wed: 8.30- 10am, 3rd Wed: 4-6pm, 4th Wed 10am-12pm, 5th Wed: 8.30-10.30am

Wickbourne Centre - Clun Road, BN17 7DZ

The Wickbourne Centre is a community hub and the home of the Arun East Family Hub as well as Arun Church and the Refresh coffee shop. The hub has a small free food pantry where visitors can help themselves to five items per visit, as well as a range of different support services for families including issuing food bank vouchers.

Creative Heart Community Cafe - 42 Beach Road, Littlehampton. BN17 5HT Creative Heart is a not-for-profit community hub and cafe. They aim to be a safe and inclusive space that tackles loneliness, inspires creativity, and improves emotional, physical and mental wellbeing. They have a regular cafe as well as sessions for people with dementia, people looking for friendships, toddler groups, arts clubs and lots more.

Cafe is open Tues - Fri 9.30am - 4pm and Saturdays 9.30 - 1pm
